Greetings Friends,

When we send our young boys and girls out to defend our country, we need to be prepared to help the men and women fight their battles when they return home; their mental, physical and material needs.

That's exactly what Forgotten Eagles does. This non-profit 501c3 organization, based solely on donations, steps in and assists with many different situations for our Veterans. Every case is different but what doesn't change is our dedication to help those who have returned home from serving our country and find themselves in need of assistance.



Not many organizations can say that 100% of your donation goes towards the cause (our expenses are less than 1% for paper and printing). We are strictly run by volunteers and there is no overhead as we all work virtual or meet in public places. When a situation is brought to our attention, it is vetted through our board where we verify they are an honorary discharged Michigan Veteran. We have over 300 volunteers across the state that will walk beside them to navigate the system. We will contact area agencies and ministries that we can partner with to get them past whatever roadblock is stopping them.

From medical, house fires, homelessness, financial assistance (no monies are given directly to the veteran), moving expenses, food, counseling, employment to just being that ear in the middle of the night when they see suicide as their only option. Forgotten Eagles is there, filling their need and helping them get re-acclimated to their surroundings. Last year in Michigan, between all of our chapters, approximately \$70,000 in services was given to hundreds of our Veterans. Our West Michigan Chapter 5 distributed \$38,000 to assist our local veterans.

- Steve called me and had lost all hope. He was married with 2 beautiful daughters. Getting on with "normal" life was difficult and he felt like a failure. Steve was sitting in a field with a loaded gun in his mouth. I talked with him for a few minutes and got him to lower his weapon and talk to me. I assured him that if his obstacle was bills that we could help. I got him to talk about his girls and what he would say to them, to convince them, that he didn't matter and they were better off without him. I was lucky...Steve laid down his gun that day and went home to his family and Forgotten Eagles assisted to get him back on track. ~Mark (V.P.)
- A WWII Veteran and his wife were raising their 2 and 3 year old great grandchildren as their only caregivers. They were well in to their 80's and lived in a modest home off Apple in Muskegon. It was Christmas and the house had a 3 foot tree on an end stand with no presents to be found and very little food in the house. We were able to provide gifts for the kids and a huge turkey with all the fixins. The Vet teared up and said he could invite his whole family to dinner now...they hadn't eaten together for years. The looks of gratitude and relief on their faces are why I keep doing this. ~Ric (President)
